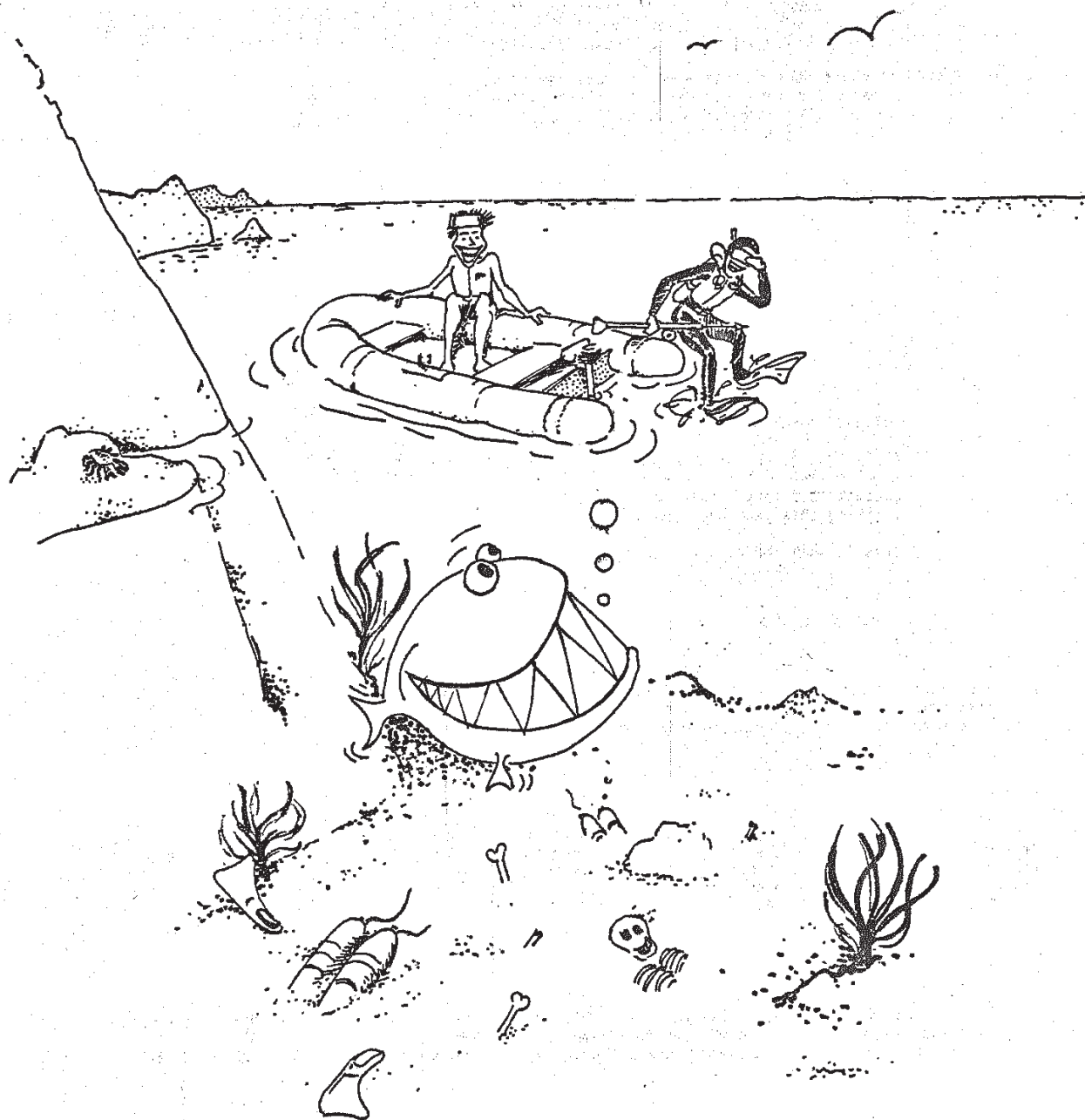

### ONCOMING TRIPS

Apart from those spontaneous (the weather looks good for this weekend) trips, we have arranged three Charter Boat weekends for this term, and all those advertised on the Combined Clubs trip list are available as well.

1. Weekend Trip on June 21 and 22:

Leaves from Whitianga on the famous dive boat the "Whai". This will be 14 or 16 divers doing 2 say trips or 10 divers doing one overnight trip either to the Mercury Islands or the Aldermans (depends on people on board the trip). Approximate cost per diver travel \$10.00, boat (2 days) \$25.00, food \$5.00, accomodation \$7.00 (2 nights) and other up to the diver. The only fixed cost in that of the boat and transport can be arranged. Usually works out at around \$50.00.

2. August 16, 17 and 18:

16 divers on board the "MV Pegasus" leaving from Auckland (Marsden Wharf) - Wake up at Great Barrier (morning of the 16th) to three days for the cost of two - \$50.00 air, food and accomodation inclusive.

3. August 23 and 24:

Drive up to Tutukaka on Friday evening and stay (all 12 of us) in this house basement, next morning we're at nearby wharf and soon after steering for the clear way, colours and fish of the deep, light blue waters of the Poor Knights. 2 day trips, \$13.00 per head per day, travel \$10.00, air up there \$2.50 per fill, accomodation \$3.00 per night and other up to diver. This trip never fails except for when there's a hurricane, but even this does not take away the trips appeal.

Booking of these trips is a two step process. First put your name of the interested list with phone number which is posted on the noticeboard. Second, is to come along to Clubsroom in the Gym meetings at lunchtime (1.00pm) on Tuesdays, meet the trips officer and confirm your place. Trips are always booked and payed for 2 weeks in advance of the date so that if the trip isn't going to fill we can pull out without the skipper charging us. However we have booked these trips in what we believe are student appealing times, just after Bursary etc.

We will arrange (on demand) other trips into the Hauraki Gulf and the Bay of Islands on boats which are available to us. The Hauraki Gulf trips will leave from Half Moon Bay and cost \$10.00 per day per diver. Interested? Put your name on appropriate list and we will ring you when one comes up, you may or may not be interested.

Overland, camping trips are largely up to whoever wants to do it, club boat, tents etc. are available and also info on places, compressor hire or location near camp site, techniques of cray catching etc. If you do this sort of thing, advertise it if you want others along, on noticeboard or through next flotsam. 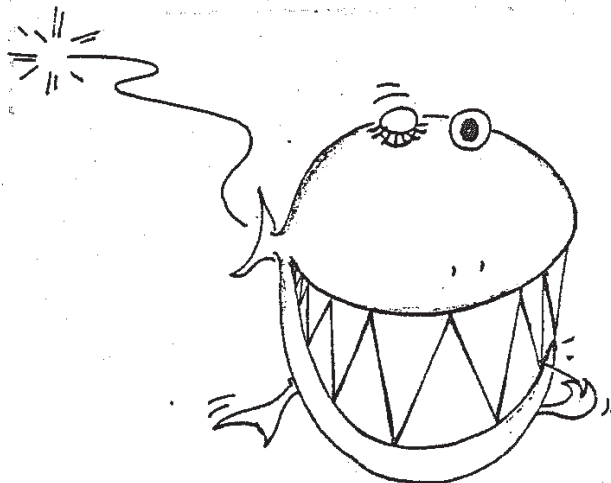
